

Residual Gift Language

A residual bequest comes to us after your estate expenses and specific bequests are paid:

I give and devise to the West Shore Foundation, located in New Cumberland, PA, all (or state a percentage) of the rest, residue, and remainder of my estate, both real and personal, to be used for its general support (or for the support of a specific fund or project).

Specific Gift Language

Naming the West Shore Foundation as a beneficiary of a specific amount or percentage of your estate is easy:

I give and devise to the West Shore Foundation, located in New Cumberland, PA, the sum of \$ _____ (%) to be used for its general support (or for the support of a specific fund or project).

Contingent Gift Language

The West Shore Foundation can be named as a contingent beneficiary in your will or personal trust if one or more of your specific bequests cannot be fulfilled:
